

Patient Primary Concern

My lower front teeth are crowded

Diagnosis

- Upper and lower arch with moderate crowding
- Moderate deep overbite
- Lack of buccal crown torque of upper central incisors
- Mild to moderate generalized gingival recession, specifically on the area of lower incisors

Treatment Duration: 8.5 Months U: 34 L: 32

Treatment Plan

- Minimized proclination of lower incisors
- Improve alignment of upper and lower incisors keeping the same canine relationship
- Add buccal crown torque to upper central incisors
- Maintain arch coordination

Results

• Improved alignment of the upper and lower front teeth without proclining lower incisors since there was unfavorable periodontal support
