Percent of 2015 sales by region*



Oral health improvement initiatives

We've committed more than \$1.5 million in financial and product donations to various organizations on an annual basis. - Thousands of children receiving dental sealant treatment through Oral Health

America's National Sealant Alliance. Dental sealants are plastic coatings applied to the chewing surfaces of the teeth to protect against tooth decay, the most common chronic disease of childhood.

- Thousands of people receiving aid through the Dentistry Canada Fund for costly oral health treatment.
- Thousands of children receiving health education and dental care through the European Academy for Pediatric Dentistry's network of associations.

Meeting the dental needs of a global population requires extensive research and education. To support this, Dentsply Sirona partners worldwide with dental institutions, including every US dental school, to contribute to the development of next-generation solutions for better, safer, and faster dental care. We feel that by supporting this, we will all reap the benefits by having better educated dental professionals, high-quality products, and practices.





With our combined 200 dental professionals employed worldwide, the expertise provided through our innovation, education, research, and development cycle is unmatched. This philosophy we've instilled is showing through the pipeline of work and making a difference in the dentistry world. We're seeing engaged dental professionals who understand the needs of their patients and are united around ambitious ways to provide better care.

By working in tandem with student scientists, faculty research, and clinical education, we are creating a world in which people can receive the dental care they need by highly qualified dental professionals. And, we're providing education and support to smooth adoption and ensure the benefits of innovations are realized.

A few examples of these programs can be seen below:

The ADA/Dentsply Sirona Student Clinician Research Program was initiated in 1959 to commemorate the centennial of the ADA in New York City as a joint venture between the American Dental Association and Dentsply Sirona (then DENTSPLY International). Since its inception over half a century ago, the program has expanded to include 18 national programs covering 39 countries and more than 7,000 students from around the world.

Students and their faculty advisors have developed new techniques and procedures through university-based oral health research by participating in the ADA/Dentsply Sirona Student Clinician Research Program. The talented students who earn the prestigious national title are hosted by Dentsply Sirona to attend the American Dental Association annual session where they have the unique opportunity to present their research with other national winners at the global SCADA program.

The SCADA program (Student Clinician Research program of the ADA) is comprised of a select and elite group of dentists who participated in the Student Clinician Research Program at their individual schools and their country's national program. SCADA helps create dental leaders who benefit their communities by promoting health, relieving pain, and protecting smiles. Many of the former student clinicians have gone on to become leaders in the dentistry profession. Some serve as academic leaders, others as leading scientists, many as outstanding clinicians and teachers.

Dentsply Sirona supports other educational programs such as the ADEA (American Dental Education Association), IFDEA (International Federation of Dental Education Association), AGD (Academy of General Dentistry), and several grants to various schools and universities around the globe. With our partnership to all of these programs and associations, we've been able to assist the next





generation of dental professionals to gain a complete understanding of dentistry and equip them with the necessary tools to be a leader in dentistry in their respective community.

In the dental industry, learning never ceases. Not only do we partner with several global student organizations and programs, we also take the time to continue education for dental professionals. Each year we educate more than 339,000 dental professionals and team members to help advance their clinical skills and knowledge of the dental industry by participating in over 10,800 Dentsply Sirona sponsored continuing education courses. These courses are conducted in 87 countries located all around the globe. Providing education and support with our continuing education courses allows us to ensure the benefits of innovations are realized and maximized.



Code of Business Conduct and Ethics Guiding Principles

The merger of Dentsply and Sirona brings together two companies which have a long history and reputation of ethical business practices throughout the global community. Through frequent and clear communications and interactive training, Dentsply Sirona employees and business partners are informed that illegal or unethical conduct will not be tolerated. The Company’s Code of Business Conduct and Ethics (the Code) sets forth our guiding values and principles for the conduct of our business which must be followed by everyone who does business on behalf of Dentsply Sirona.

Company supervisors and managers are responsible for ensuring compliance with the Code by the personnel whom they lead. All employees are responsible for acquiring sufficient knowledge to recognize potential compliance issues applicable to their duties and for appropriately seeking advice from subject matter experts regarding such issues.

The Code has been distributed to all employees and sets forth the general standards relevant to the Company’s business and operations. In addition, there are numerous policies and procedures which

provide more detailed guidance on a variety of topics. The Company communicates these specific policies to personnel who are particularly affected by them and seeks full compliance in the conduct of the Company’s business. Dentsply Sirona’s Marketing to Professional Code of Conduct requires all interactions with medical and dental professionals are compliant with applicable laws and regulations, as well as our core values. Additionally, Dentsply Sirona is committed to the reporting requirements of the Physicians Payment Sunshine Act (Open Payments) and other transparency laws worldwide. Employees who interact with dental professionals are required to take training and agree to comply with the Marketing to Professionals Code of Conduct. These policies are changed or supplemented from time to time as required.

Dentsply Sirona supports global efforts to address the issues of exploitation, slavery, and human trafficking through our internal policies as well as through direct actions with our business partners in our supply chain. We expect all of our employees and business partners to fully comply with the California Transparency in Supply Chain Act of 2010 and the UK Modern Slavery Act of 2015, and the Conflict Minerals provisions of the US Dodd-Frank Act of 2010.

Ethics and Compliance Committee

Dentsply Sirona’s Chief Compliance Officer leads our global ethics and compliance efforts. Together with the Chief Compliance Officer, a cross-functional Ethics and Compliance Committee promotes a work environment and policies that uphold the highest ethical standards for all Dentsply Sirona locations and business partners. Under this committee’s charter, our ethics and compliance initiatives illustrate Dentsply Sirona’s strong commitment to our Core Values which set behavioral expectations for our employees, business partners and industry consultants. Improving Oral Health in the Global Community

As a leader in the dental industry, Dentsply Sirona recognizes that the greatest contributions the Company can make to the global community are through advocacy and support of efforts that improve the oral health of under-served children and adults. To that end, the funding priorities of Dentsply Sirona include:

1. Improve oral health and access for children and adults through support of oral health education, treatment, and prevention programs.
2. Support for dental education and research to sustain the viability of the dental profession.
3. Sustain healthy communities where we live, work, and serve through support of health, education, and social service agencies.

On an annual basis, Dentsply Sirona supports thousands of charitable events and activities around the world, several of which focus heavily on education of oral health for children. We believe that a strong understanding of oral health from a young age promotes healthy habits and helps to dramatically reduce the

chance of oral diseases and health problems later in life. Some of the most impactful events and initiatives this year included the following.

Water Street Health Services

Water Street Health Services is a nonprofit program of the Water Street Mission in Lancaster, Pennsylvania. This program is the largest nonprofit provider of free dental care to the homeless and needy in York and Lancaster Counties. To date, this program has served over 6,000 patients with quality dental care. Being a nonprofit and providing free dental care to thousands of people makes it difficult to keep their dental equipment in top shape. Recently, one of their dental chairs was damaged beyond repair, and they were in desperate need of a new one.

So, Dentsply Sirona stepped into action and provided them with new equipment, including a state-of-the-art Treatment Center. Dentsply Sirona is excited to donate equipment to a great cause like this, and the team at Water Street Health Services was extremely appreciative to have a new patient chair. It even brought some of their staff to tears. In addition, Dentsply Sirona's Day with Dentsply Sirona educational

event in Lancaster Country for dental professionals donated a portion of seminar fees to Water Street Health Services in 2016.

Dental Innovation Foundation

The Dental Innovation Foundation under the Royal Patronage with Srinakharinwirot University at Phicit Province in Thailand is an outreach program at the university that provides dental clinics throughout the Phicit Province. Dentsply Sirona participates in this program by providing a team of dental experts and Dentsply Sirona's CEREC system to be used at the dental clinics. Our team of experts not only uses CEREC to treat patients in a single visit, but also lends their knowledge and expertise to help educate citizens of the Phicit Province on healthy dental habits and practices. Our experts also provide training to the local dentists on the CEREC Omnicam, an intraoral scanner, to help enhance the accessibility of high-quality dental care.

This program demonstrates our core mission and values by delivering innovative dental solutions to improve oral health worldwide. The patients of the program do not have access to advanced dental solutions in their local dental facilities. By

Box of Hope

Box of Hope is a registered Hong Kong charity aimed at providing useful, educational gifts to underprivileged children in Hong Kong and the surrounding areas. Box of Hope, at its core, teaches the gift of giving to those less fortunate. After seeing gifts being prepared by her children in school, a Dentsply Sirona Hong Kong employee, Stephanie Gaylard, gathered fellow Dentsply Sirona employees together to participate in this event as a way to help promote healthy dental habits for children. Saving Teeth. Changing Lives.

The benefits of keeping our natural teeth are significant and far-reaching. Tooth retention impacts more than our oral health. arthritis, pulmonary diseases, and cancer.



we are providing the highest quality services and products to our customers. The broad experience and knowhow of more than 600 research and development employees translates into more than 30 innovative new products created annually.

A. Pre-Clinical Testing

Dentsply Sirona develops and licenses numerous medical devices for use in dental care applications. The vast majority of the products we develop are substantially greater in quality compared to products already available on the market. Whenever possible, Dentsply Sirona uses in vitro or benchtop methods that do not require testing in animals. When studies involving animals are absolutely necessary (e.g. when required by law, regulation or standards) to establish safety, Dentsply Sirona uses facilities that follow the relevant national guidelines for the Care and Use of Animals. In the U.S., this follows 21CFR Part 58 and 9CFR Parts 1-3 and global ISO 10993-2 (Animal Welfare Requirements). These guidelines require that all studies be approved by an Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee and the number of animals are limited to the minimum amount possible to demonstrate safety and efficacy prior to human clinical studies. Within these facilities, animal research monitoring is required to ensure that the animals are treated safely and humanely.

B. Clinical Testing

Prior to commercializing innovative products, Dentsply Sirona often utilizes data from human clinical tests. Dentsply Sirona conducts all studies with human subjects in a manner that protects the safety and rights of patients and investigators. In addition to protecting the rights of individuals including confidentiality, Dentsply Sirona complies with regulatory requirements of the countries in which studies are conducted and those in which regulatory submissions take place. Dentsply Sirona's practice ensures that controls are in place and followed to protect the integrity of the study results.

C. Dental Amalgam

Dental amalgam, which is composed of a mixture of metals such as silver, mercury, copper, and tin, is considered a safe, affordable, and durable material that has been used for over 100 years to restore teeth affected by dental caries (tooth decay). It has a long-established record of safety and effectiveness. While it has been the subject of questions because of its mercury content, dental amalgam has been studied and reviewed extensively and continues to be preferred and used by dental professionals in certain clinical applications. Dentsply Sirona sells numerous restorative products that are alternatives to amalgam.

Many organizations, including the American Dental Association, Federation Dentaire Internationale (World Dental Federation) and the FDA, support the use of dental amalgam. The

Company has reviewed and evaluated its dental amalgam product line. This review included assessment of a wide range of factors, including the clinical effectiveness of amalgam, published scientific studies regarding material safety, the results of the FDA review of dental amalgam, as well as environmental and legal considerations. Based on our internal assessment and published industry research, Dentsply Sirona concludes that dental amalgam continues to be a useful restorative material whose safety and efficacy has been extensively documented.

Based on this assessment and the needs of customers, Dentsply Sirona expects to continue to responsibly manufacture and sell dental amalgam while focusing research and development investments on advanced alternative dental-restorative materials. In agreement with the Minamata Convention, Dentsply Sirona supports the consensus for a phase-down approach, ratified by the Convention and signed by over 100 countries, to reduce the use of dental amalgams. Dentsply Sirona's marketing efforts and educational activities are designed to educate clinicians about the benefits and techniques for using today's state-of-the-art alternative restorative solutions. In addition, Dentsply Sirona continues to promote the use of the American Dental Association's Best Management Practices for Amalgam Waste to customers who choose to use dental amalgam. Finally, Dentsply Sirona supports a variety of industry-wide initiatives to promote prevention of oral health disease, which in turn, reduces the need for restorative procedures.

Environment



A. Energy Resources

Dentsply Sirona manufactures products located in facilities around the world. The nature of our manufacturing businesses is such that we are not a significant consumer of natural resources or energy. In fact, Dentsply Sirona's global electricity and natural gas consumption costs total less than 1% of our sales.

Although we are not large consumers of energy, we are committed to improving our ability to control our energy consumption and reduce it. Currently, our Ballaigues, Switzerland facility uses photovoltaic panels to produce 1,189m² of electricity used by the facility. It has also implemented an automatic store system to limit solar heating. This is guided by an automatic weather management system. This facility also uses thermal recovery with high efficiency for all HVAC systems. Dentsply Sirona tracks baseline energy impact based on metric tons of CO₂ (type 1 and type 2) to gain a view of Dentsply Sirona's global energy consumption and related greenhouse gas emissions. This dashboard provides a

view of our cost efficiency and greenhouse gas emission opportunities. The use of this data supports our participation and reporting in the Carbon Disclosure Project (CDP). We have continued to enhance our understanding of our Type 3 CO₂ impact. For example, in 2016 we expanded our Type 3 understanding beyond North America to include Europe and in the near future, other regions.

Several Dentsply Sirona facilities in Europe are already obtaining up to 20% or more of their energy needs from renewable energy sources, including wind and solar power.

Adjacent to energy management, we began to extend the progress we made last year in reducing our impact on the environment through our managed print service (MPS) program.

In 2016, we began the effort to implement the MPS program with our top priority European sites starting sometime in 2017. As a result, we have improved our CDP score three years in a row.

B. Hazardous Waste

Our manufacturing facilities do not produce large amounts of hazardous wastes and emissions, based on the type of manufactured materials and the size of our manufacturing footprint. In prior years, we've reported U.S. manufacturing facility permits related to the environment. For 2016 and beyond, we're expanding to a global reporting basis, encompassing permits worldwide. Six of our manufacturing facilities have hazardous waste permits, 18 manufacturing facilities have air emission permits or authorizations, four of our manufacturing facilities are required to have landfill disposal licenses or permits, and we own five water (emission/storm/waste) permits. We strive to ensure that our manufacturing facilities are in compliance with those licenses and permits. Each manufacturing facility tracks and reports their hazardous waste and emissions on an annual basis.

C. Local Teams Go Green

Our employees are motivated to reduce Dentsply Sirona's negative environmental impact by focusing on ways we can reduce energy consumption, increase recycling, eliminate waste, and implement other "green" ideas within our local facilities. Through our partnership with Schneider Electric, local teams

have access to statistical data to support their investment decisions related to the reduction of energy consumption with measurable results in both costs and usage. Several facilities have already begun developing environmental impact reduction strategies.

Making positive impacts on the environment and the workplace

Our Bensheim, Germany location has received its ISO 14001 certification and follows the worldwide recognized guideline for health and safety measures (NLF/ILO-OSH 2001). The ISO 14001 certification is provided by the International Organization for Standardization and is a systematic and process-driven approach to controlling aspects of our business that have a significant impact on the environment.

The NLF/ILO-OSH 2001 guidelines are a set of safety measures that have been developed by the International Labor Organization (ILO) and are a set of safety measures put in place to reduce the hazards and risks in the workplace. Our goal is to provide a safe and risk-free environment for our employees to thrive.

SELECTIVE EXAMPLES OF GREEN INITIATIVES



HAZARDOUS WASTE

- US based facility implemented CNC grinding, reducing acid waste by 90% and electrolyte solution waste by 50%
- US-based facility eliminated use of all white bliss boxes by converting to environmentally friendly unbleached box packaging
- Many facilities around the globe reuse or recycle a majority of raw materials and packaging materials to reduce pollution and carbon footprint
- US-based facility using green custodial supplies where suitable
- Swedish-based facility recycles solvent emission and metallic waste
- Swedish-based facility improved chemical handling for surface treatment, leading to less waste




WATER USAGE

CARBON EMISSIONS

- German-based facility installed new gas heater system, reducing gas usage by 20-30%

- Swedish and Belgium-based facilities implemented strategy to improve car fleet efficiency to reduce CO2 emissions
- Netherlands-based facility replaced gasoline powered cars with electrical cars
- Germany-based facility reduced natural gas consumption by 21% by optimizing production and maintenance scheduling
- Swedish-based facility reduced the use and leakage of Sulfur hexafluoride gas (SF6) which reduced the CO2 footprint by 50% the last three years

Political Spending

Dentsply Sirona does not use corporate funds for political spending or lobbying on political issues, and has not done so for at least the last six years, nor do we have a political action committee. As stated in our Code of Business Conduct and Ethics, the Company's established policy is that no company funds or other company assets may be contributed for political purposes, regardless of whether in the U.S. or outside the U.S., without the prior review by the Company's General Counsel, and approval by the Board of Directors.

In the U.S., Dentsply Sirona is a member of the Dental Trade Alliance (DTA), an association of companies that provide dental equipment, supplies, materials and services to dentists and other oral care professionals. The DTA's core purpose is to enhance member success and increase dental demand. From time to time, DTA

may engage in lobbying regarding legislation that is of interest to its members.

With headquarters in York, Pennsylvania, Dentsply Sirona is also a member of the Pennsylvania Chamber of Business and Industry. The Chamber is the commonwealth's largest broad-based business advocacy organization with a mission to improve Pennsylvania's business climate and increase the competitive advantage for its members.

Based on inquiries with US-based trade associations to which our membership fees exceed \$20,000, the Company has determined that the amount of such dues or payments that may have been used for lobbying purposes is inconsequential, and no portion of such dues or payments have been used for political contributions.

Dentsply Sirona has a long history of supporting the communities in which we live, work and serve. Dentsply Sirona's Corporate Responsibility Platform represents our efforts to report on our sustainable activities and sharpen our philanthropic focus in the area where we have the greatest impact - improving the oral health of under-served populations.
